## **OVERVIEW**

First created in 2002, the **Chancellor's Office** and **Student Success** partner in providing Mission Statement Scholarships totaling \$6,000 each year. Three students (rising seniors) are presented a \$2,000 award in recognition for demonstrating excellence in fulfilling the TCU mission.

## **APPLICATION DETAILS**

Who can apply?	Rising seniors based on credit hour, and they must be in good standing with the university. December graduates are welcome to participate.Students are only allowed to apply once, so if you are just barely a junior by hours but will remain a junior during the next application period, you may consider applying at a later time. Please use your best judgment to decide, but know you are only eligible to apply once.Students currently receiving any type of scholarship or financial aid, including those on a tuition benefit or tuition exchange because they have a family member working at TCU or another university, should contact financial aid before applying to make sure they are eligible. It is the responsibility of the applicant to check their eligibility.
Application Deadline	Monday, February 26 at 11:59 pm
Recommendation Letters	Students must submit three total recommendations, one from each of the following categories:   1. TCU Faculty Member   2. TCU Faculty Member or TCU Professional Staff Member   3. Anyone Inside or Outside the TCU Community (non-parent or guardian)   Recommenders should submit their letter through this form:   https://engage.tcu.edu/submitter/form/start/622658

Recommendation Letters	Recommendations should, as much as possible, address the applicant's qualifications with regard to each point of the TCU Mission Statement: <b>"To educate individuals to think and act as ethical leaders and responsible</b> <b>citizens in the global community</b> ."
Selection Process	A diverse committee from TCU community is called on to review applications and provide finalists to the Chancellor, President, and Provost for scholarship selection.
	<u>Members of the committee cannot serve as recommenders for scholarship</u> <u>applicants.</u>
	Various parts of the application are each scored and weighted as follows:
	Reflective Writing Submission (60%)
	Letters of Recommendation (30%; 10% each)
	Resume Highlights (10%)
Application Components	A complete application must include:
	1. Three recommendation letters
	a. Specific requirements listed above
	b. Recommender must submit through the form by Feb. 26, 2024
	2. Your well-crafted resume
	3. Four essays (150-250 words each) about each component of the TCU Mission Statement
	4. Any other considerations for the Selection Committee
