

TCU Mission Statement Scholarship

Recommendation Request + Submission Details

OVERVIEW

First created in 2002, the **Chancellor's Office** and **Student Success** partner in providing Mission Statement Scholarships totaling \$6,000 each year. Three students (rising seniors) are presented a \$2,000 award in recognition for demonstrating excellence in fulfilling the TCU mission.

APPLICATION DETAILS

Who can apply?	<p>Rising seniors based on credit hour, and they <u>must</u> be in good standing with the university. December graduates are welcome to participate.</p> <p>Students are only allowed to apply <i>once</i>, so if you are just barely a junior by hours but will remain a junior during the next application period, you may consider applying at a later time. Please use your best judgment to decide, but know you are only eligible to apply once.</p> <p>Students currently receiving any type of scholarship or financial aid, including those on a tuition benefit or tuition exchange because they have a family member working at TCU or another university, should contact financial aid before applying to make sure they are eligible. <u>It is the responsibility of the applicant to check their eligibility.</u></p>
Application Deadline	Monday, February 26 at 11:59 pm
Recommendation Letters	<p>Students must submit three total recommendations, one from each of the following categories:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. TCU Faculty Member2. TCU Faculty Member or TCU Professional Staff Member3. Anyone Inside or Outside the TCU Community (non-parent or guardian) <p>Recommenders should submit their letter through this form: https://engage.tcu.edu/submitter/form/start/622658</p>

Recommendation Letters	<p><i>Recommendations should, as much as possible, address the applicant's qualifications with regard to each point of the TCU Mission Statement: "To educate individuals to think and act as ethical leaders and responsible citizens in the global community."</i></p>
Selection Process	<p>A diverse committee from TCU community is called on to review applications and provide finalists to the Chancellor, President, and Provost for scholarship selection.</p> <p><u>Members of the committee cannot serve as recommenders for scholarship applicants.</u></p> <p>Various parts of the application are each scored and weighted as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reflective Writing Submission (60%) ● Letters of Recommendation (30%; 10% each) ● Resume Highlights (10%)
Application Components	<p>A complete application must include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Three recommendation letters <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Specific requirements listed above b. Recommender must submit through the form by Feb. 26, 2024 2. Your well-crafted resume 3. Four essays (150-250 words each) about each component of the TCU Mission Statement 4. Any other considerations for the Selection Committee
